They fly the screaming war birds with nerves of steel and rule the skies with an iron hand, and on Wednesday they go bowling. They're

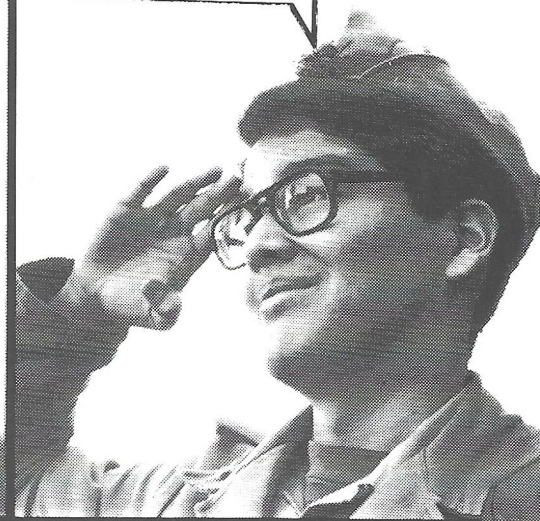
